This is a difficult burden for our small rural district with few commercial enterprises to draw upon - we are grateful for our generous local community and surrounding neighbors who donate to our foundations and volunteer in classrooms or at fundraisers regularly. La Honda Elementary School is very special; it has many highly educated parent volunteers assisting in the classrooms and on campus every day. This high quality of education is important to us, no matter how small the district or how tight the budget, and we work hard to do whatever we need to do to preserve it!
